

Menstrual Hygiene Management programme gets underway

Thiruvananthapuram, Feb 21 (UNI) The second phase of Menstrual Hygiene Management programme of Kerala State Women's Development Corporation (KSWDC) began with an awareness class for girl students at Veeranakavu in Kattakkada on Wednesday.

Speaking on the occasion, KSWDC Managing Director Ms VC Bindu said the 'She Pad' project being implemented in the state is the first of its kind in the country.

KSWDC has been implementing the 'She Pad' project in 500 schools in 141 Panchayats, benefitting 15000 girl students.

The She-pad project is introduced among the adolescents girls in Govt/Aided schools in Kerala to promote good hygienic practices to influence the quality of life of women.

For this project, high quality sanitary napkins and incinerators to burn the used napkins are supplied by HLL Life Care Ltd.
